Each term students at Faith City School are offered the opportunity to participate in Extra-Curricular Sports Teams for seasonal





IMPORTANT NOTICE ABOUT SCHOOL DONATIONS FOR 2020

The Faith City School Board of Trustees have accepted a funding offer from the Ministry of Education which will commence from Jan 2020. This funding offer means that each child who attends Faith City School will be funded \$150.00 per student for the school year - providing that the school no longer charges our Parents/Caregivers for donations.

From Term 1 2020 Parents/Caregivers Accounts will no longer be charged an Activity Donation each term (Currently \$45.00 per term per child)

Parents / Caregivers will also no longer be charged a Bus Travel Donation each term (Currently \$10.00 per term per child).

There will still be accounts sent out from the school for non-donation items such as; charges for school stationery purchased, pupil record books, extra-curricular sports etc.

Parents / Caregivers will still be asked to contribute to the cost of School Camps. Our next school camp is scheduled for the end of 2020

The Proprietors will still continue to charge the Proprietorship Charge each term for each student (for the up-keep of the school property, buildings, maintenance etc) The Proprietorship accounts will continue issued termly from Faith City Church.
