Cross Country Programme

Faith City students have been training hard for their cross country races this week, and before lockdown. So this year we will be holding our cross country event under Level 2 guidelines. This means that races will be staggered throughout the day on Wednesday 15th September.

You are welcome to come and watch your children race, but we need to keep the gatherings under 100. If you are coming to watch, please stay behind the roped off parent area on the Springvale Road wide of the field. You will be able to see the finish line from there.

We still have certificates for the winners but there will be no formal prizegiving this year. All students will be encouraged to race and will receive an ice block at the end of their race. Please make sure students bring a drink bottle, PE gear and sports shoes.

Races: Time: Track:	11 and older Boys / 11 and older Girls 10am start once around the main track on field, behind Room 4, 5 & 6, across Cathro Road, up Tony's Hill doing full track and back around field to finish
Races: Time: Track:	9 & 10 year old Boys / 9 & 10 year old Girls 11.30am once around main track on field, behind Room 4, 5 & 6, up Tony's Hill doing half track, back round field to finish
Races: Time: Track:	5 & 6 year old Boys / 5 & 6 year old Girls 1.00pm Twice around main track on field
Races: Time: Track:	7 & 8 year old Boys / 7 & 8 year old Girls 2.10pm Once around the main track on field, around court track, past Room 4, back around main track again to finish line
