#### From the Principal's desk

Spring is just around the corner now. It will be a relief to have a reprieve from a cold and wet August!

We have had an awesome last few weeks with a number of highlights. Just this Wednesday we hosted Cornerstone Christian School for our second annual sports exchange. The day started with a Whakatau – brief Māori greeting – with our Kapa Haka team leading along with our Kaumatua, Nare Whittaker and Whaia Nadia Puaha who takes our Te Reo and Kapa Haka programme on Fridays. Thank you for the great work that you are doing with our ākonga. The teams then met and played several games. Our Years 5/6 netball team played and beat Cornerstone's Years 5/6 team. They also played Cornerstone's Years 7/8 team and beat them too, and just went down to the Faith City's Years 7/8 team by 6 goals. Our Years 7/8 Basketball team also won their game well. Xanu placed second with a speech about his grandfather and Nicolas won the Junior Competition with his speech. That is an outstanding result for Faith City among seven schools!

The recent cross-country race was also a great highlight. The parental support was so good, and the kids ran their best on a heavy track. I saw Clara Biggs lose her shoe in the mud when she was out in front. She calmly went back and retrieved her shoe and put it back on while several students shot past her. On it went, off she went, and before too long was back out in front and winning her race. Not bad for a Year 2 student!

Thanks to all our parental support over the last little while with these and other events – we literally could not do it without you.

Next term, we will be preparing for our Camps and Adventure days. 
